### The Similan's and Surin Islands - 6 Days

22 Dives - 6 Days / 6 Nights

#### FRIDAY

**05.03.2010** - Leave from Patong Bay at 21:00. Travel overnight to the fantastic Similan Islands.

#### SATURDAY

**06.03.2010** - Three day-dives around the Similan Islands. With a chance late afternoon to visit island no.4 for a couple of hours. Dive #4 a night dive in Donald Duck bay at island no.4. Stay onboard overnight in one of the secluded bays. Relax and watch a film or read a book.

#### SUNDAY

**07.03.2010** - Dive #5 at the Similan Islands , then onward travel to Koh Bon for Dives #6 and #7. Dive #8 could be either a sunset dive at Koh Tachai or a night dive at Koh Tachai. Stay onboard overnight at Koh Tachai. Watch a film or get an early night!

#### MONDAY

**08.03.2010** - Dive #9 is at Koh Tachai, then onward to the world famous dive site Richelieu Rock for Dives #10 and #11. Dive #12 could be either a sunset dive at Koh Tachai or a night dive at Koh Bon.

#### TUESDAY

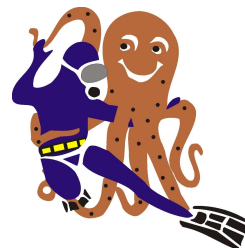
**09.03.2010** - Dive #13 at Koh Tachai, dive #14 at Koh Bon, then continue south back to the Similan Islands. Dives #15 and #16 in the Similan Islands . Dive #16 either sunset or night dive.

#### WEDNESDAY

**10.03.2010** - Dives #17, #18, #19 and #20 are in the Similan Islands. Enjoy an afternoon trip to Island no.8, for those with lots of energy join our tour leader on a hike to the viewpoint, a perfect place to get some amazing photos of the Islands and the Andaman Sea.

#### THURSDAY

**11.03.2010** - Dives #21 and #22 in the south of the Similan chain, Boulder City and Shark Fin Reef, perfect sites for the final dives with chances to see all life - big and small. Then it's time to head back to Patong Bay. Disembarkation at Patong Bay, 18:00.

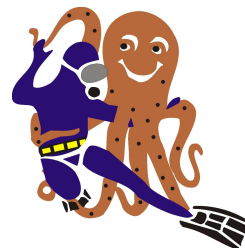


MV Colona VI - Upper Deck

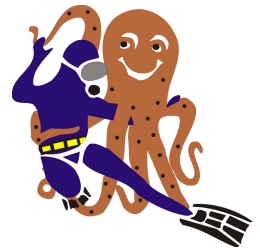

## **Additional payments onboard**

### **National Marine Park Fee**

Nearly all the diving done is in National Marine Parks. This involves a fee that goes directly to funding the Park Rangers that look after the park and the maintenance and installation of mooring buoys.

This means that currently there are the following Marine Park Fee's to be paid onboard:

6 Day 6 Night Northern Cruise                      2000 Thai Baht

### **Equipment Rental**

Torch rental:    Free of Charge

Nitrox Tanks:    250 Thai Baht per tank

### **Prices for liveboard cruise include:**

Transfers to and from your accommodation on Phuket Island.  
Accommodation on board, all meals, soft drinks with meals, snacks, drinking water, tea, coffee, tanks (not NITROX), weights, weight belts, and dive guide.

### **Prices for liveboard cruises do not include:**

Soft drinks (except at meal times), alcohol, Similan Marine National Park Fee, diving courses, nitrox tanks, rental equipment (except torches for night dives etc.), tip for the crew
